General

BresoTec Inc. respects your right to privacy and believes that our highest priority is protecting the personal information of everyone that visits our site or utilizes our services. This Privacy Policy states how Bresotec will gather, use and protect any personal information collected over this site. By accessing this website, you agree to the terms of this privacy policy in its most recent form and you agree to the collection and use of your personal information as stated.

While using the site, you may be asked to voluntarily provide Bresotec with personal information that can be used to contact or identify you. Bresotec may keep logs of your IP address, the time and date of your visit, the pages you access and various other statistical data that is not used to monitor any individuals, but rather aids us in maintaining the site and improving the user experience. This information is solely for Bresotec's use and will not be sold or distributed to any 3rd party companies or individuals.

BresoTec Inc. Notice of Privacy Practices for compliance with HIPAA

This notice describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed. It also describes how you can get access to this information.

This notice describes how Bresotec Inc. may use and disclose your protected health information to carry out scoring, interpretation, and payment for these services. This document also describes your rights as a customer and patient to access and control your protected health information. Protected health information is information about you, including demographics that may identify you and that relates to your past, present or future physical or mental health and related health care services.

The purpose of this notice is to comply with the HIPAA requirements pertaining to the integrity, confidentiality and the availability of electronic protected health information.

This policy covers all electronic protected health information (EPHI), which is a person's identifiable health information.

Uses and disclosures of Protected Health information

Bresotec Inc. may use or disclose your health information as follows:

- For scoring. To a certified sleep technician, to Bresotec Inc.'s automated algorithm, or to other health care providers within or outside of Bresotec Inc. who are providing scoring services, or over reading services for your doctor, dentist, or other health care provider.
- For Interpretation. To a physician or other health care provider within or outside of Bresotec Inc. who is providing interpretation services for your doctor, dentist or other health care provider.
- For diagnoses or treatment. To your doctor, dentist or health care provider to whom you have been referred. Your health care information will be used to ensure that the physician or health care provider has the necessary information to diagnose or treat you.
- For Payment. To obtain payment for service Bresotec Inc. provides to your doctor, dentist or other health care provider. This may include activities your health insurance plan may undertake if it approves or pays for the health care service Bresotec Inc. provides to your physician or health care provider and may include the determination of eligibility for plan benefits or to coordinate benefits.
- For authorization. In addition to our use of your health information for scoring, interpretation, or payment, you may give us written authorization to use your health information or to disclose it to anyone for any purpose. You may revoke your authorization at any time, in writing, except to the extent an action has already been



taken in reliance on your authorization while it was in effect. Unless you give us a written authorization, BresoTec Inc. cannot use or disclose your health information for any purpose except those described in this notice.

Other Permitted and Required Uses and Disclosures that may be made without Consent, Authorization or Opportunity to Object

BresoTec Inc. may use or disclose your health information in the following situations without your consent or authorization:

- As required by Law. BresoTec Inc. may use or disclose your health information to the extent disclosure is required by the law. You will be notified, as required by law, of a use or disclosure.
- Public Health. BresoTec Inc. may use or disclose your health information to public health authorities for purposes related to preventing or controlling disease, injury or disability, reporting to the Food and Drug Administration problems with products and reaction to products and reporting disease or infection exposure.
- Health Oversight Activities. BresoTec Inc. may disclose your health information to a health oversight agency for activities authorized by law, such as audits, investigations, inspections, licensure and other activities related to the oversight of the health care system.
- Legal proceedings. BresoTec Inc. may disclose your health information in the course of any administrative or judicial proceeding.
- Anonymous aggregate data. BresoTec Inc. may use anonymous aggregate data for information gathering and quality purposes.

Statement of your Health Information Rights

- Access. You have the right to inspect and copy your protected health information. This includes medical and billing records and any other records that your physician, dentist or other health care provider uses to make decisions about you. If you request a copy of the information, BresoTec Inc. may charge you a reasonable fee to cover expenses associated with your request.
- Right to Request Restrictions. You have the right to request restrictions on certain uses and disclosures of your health information. You may ask BresoTec Inc. not to use or disclose any part of your protected health information for the purpose of diagnoses, treatment or payment. You may also request that any part of your protected health information not be disclosed to health care providers, family members or friends who maybe involved in your care or payment for health care. Your request must state the



restriction requested and to whom you want the restrictions to apply. BresoTec Inc. is not required to agree to the restrictions you request.

- **Right to Request Amendment.** You have a right to request an amendment to your health information that was created by BresoTec Inc. that you believe is incorrect or incomplete. BresoTec Inc. is not required to change your health information. If your request is denied, BresoTec Inc. will provide you with information about our denial and tell you how to file a statement of disagreement with us. You may prepare a rebuttal to your statement, a copy of which will be provided to you.
- **Right to Accounting of Disclosures.** This right applies to disclosures for purposes other than scoring, interpretation results or payments as described in this (Notice of Privacy Practices) and disclosures made to you. Your request should specify a time period of up to six years. BresoTec Inc. will provide one list per twelve-month period free of charge. BresoTec Inc. may charge you for additional lists.
- **Confidential Communications Requirements.** You have the right to request an alternative means or location for receiving communications of protected health information other than those typically used by BresoTec Inc. BresoTec Inc. will try its utmost to accommodate reasonable requests.
- **Complaints.** You may complain to Regulatory Affairs about this (Notice of Privacy Practices) if you believe your rights under the notice have been violated. BresoTec Inc. will not retaliate against you for filing a complaint.
